### **Primary Supplies (PK 3, PK 4 & Kindergarten)**

1 box of colored pencils  
1 box of crayons  
1 pair of child-sized scissors  
1 package of glue sticks  
1 box #2 pencils  
1 black and white composition book (PRIMARY RULED with space for picture) [Staples Primary Composition Book](#) or [Walmart Mead Primary Journal](#)  
1 plain colored towel/rug to create a floor workspace at home  
1 storage box for materials (a shoe box will work or other plastic container of similar size)

### **Lower Elementary Supplies (Grades 1-3)**

#### Essential:

1 box of #2 pencils  
3 composition notebooks  
1 pair of scissors  
1 large glue stick  
1 pkg. dry erase markers  
1 small white board  
1 pack of 1/2 inch square graph paper

#### Suggested:

1 handheld pencil sharpener  
1 pkg erasers  
1 pair of headphones  
1 plastic folder  
12- Pack of colored pencils

### **Upper Elementary Supplies (Grades 4-6)**

3 book bound notebooks  
1 book bound graphing notebook  
1 notebook sized whiteboard  
2-4 dry erase markers  
A handy supply of pencils and pens

1 package Post-It Notes (any colors)  
2 highlighters of different colors  
1 pack 3x5 index cards  
1 one-hole punch (or you can use a 3-ring hole punch if you have one)  
1 large ring (like a binder ring or shower ring) to hold hole-punched index cards  
1 ruler  
1 calculation device  
1 compass  
1 protractor  
1 box colored pencils  
1 black permanent marker (Sharpie)  
1 glue stick
