## GENERAL SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST 2021-2022

Listed below are basic supplies that your child will use during the school year at each grade level. Your child's teacher may require additional materials. Please refer to the school website for classroom-specific items. We appreciate your support in providing these materials for your child; however, if you are unable to purchase any of these supplies, please contact a staff member at the school and we will be happy to provide the items for your child.

### Primary Supplies (PK 3, PK 4 & Kindergarten)

Change of clothes-shirt, pants, socks and underwear in a plastic bag labeled with child's name  
1 box of Crayola colored pencils (16 or 24)  
1 package of glue sticks  
1 vinyl pocket folders  
1 box #2 pencils  
1 plastic water bottle filled with water every day!  
1 box of crayons  
1 pair of "indoor" shoes

- Rubber soled slippers, crocs, etc.
- Please refrain from characters & cartoons
- No flip flops
- These will be left at school in the student's cubby to wear during our work cycle in the classroom

### Lower Elementary Supplies (Grades 1-3)

1 backpack  
3 large, sturdy plastic folders with pockets, plain colors  
1 pkg. color pencils  
1 pkg. sharpened #2 pencils (prefer Ticonderoga)  
1 handheld pencil sharpener  
1 pkg. large glue sticks  
3 composition notebooks  
1 pair of children's scissors (blunt tip)  
1 pair of headphones  
1 plastic water bottle filled with water every day!  
1 roll of paper towels  
1 box of tissues  
1 Clorox wipes

### Upper Elementary Supplies (Grades 4-6)

1 graph notebook (wireless)  
3 Mead Composition books (wireless)  
1 ream of plain white copy paper  
1 plastic water bottle filled with water every day!

1 1-inch binder (math & science)

3 one subject spiral notebooks (if possible, red, green & purple) that will be stored in large binder (ELA, SW & PW)  
1 three inch 3-ring binder (Mead or Trapper style) (ELA)  
1 one inch 3 ring binder (for portfolio) (ELA)  
15-page protectors  
1 zipper pencil pouch  
1 pen  
5 highlighters of different colors  
1 one-hole punch (or you can use a 3-ring hole punch if you have one)  
1 large ring (like a binder ring or shower ring) to hold hole-punched index cards
